Accessibility Flags Use for Power Carts - User Agreement

"Accessibility flag" users require a valid provincial Accessible Parking Permit and/or approval must be obtained from the Associate Professional. This policy ensures responsible "accessibility flag" usage.

The Pro Shop will not provide an "accessibility flag" without this approval.

- Carts may be taken within the fairway approach up to, but not inside, 15 feet around the putting surface. Carts shall not be driven greenside, between the green and bunkers.
- Carts must remain 15 feet off tee boxes and <u>shall not be driven</u> onto <u>any</u> <u>sloped areas around any tee box.</u>
- Pro Shop staff and on-course player assistant will monitor "accessibility flags" cart use in accordance with the above - noted guidelines.
- During certain times of the year, and/or during certain weather conditions, it may be necessary to restrict all carts, including "accessibility flag" carts to cart path only.

I have read and understand the "accessibility flags" carts guidelines and agree to abide by the accessibility flag policy.

Oakridge Golf Club allows individuals using "accessibility flags" to have some flexibility in cart use rules to accommodate their golf experience. However, these users must be mindful of the potential damage caused by carts. The following guidelines are designed to help "accessibility flag" golfers enjoy the day while ensuring that the course maintains the level of quality and safety expected by members and guests.
